Yesterday we had our Annual AGM for the Ouseburn Learning Trust. With the creation of Jesmond Park Academy as part of the Gosforth Federation of Schools Multi-Academy Trust they are no longer part of our Trust of schools.

The schools within the Ouseburn Learning Trust are:

Benton Park Primary, Hotspur Primary, Cragside Primary, Ravenswood Primary, Chillingham Road Primary and West Jesmond Primary. Christ Church C.of E. Primary is also a close associate partner school and works with our Trust.

At the AGM we agreed our exciting plan of shared events for this academic year. This will include our regular PE, Arts and Music and STEM events. Some focused work for staff including a whole Trust teacher training day in June 2020, developing our subject leadership and expertise across schools and some important peer review work looking at provision in all our Early Years classes.
