Hot Chocolate Fridays!

They are many great moments across the week for a head teacher, but a real highlight is our new Hot Chocolate Fridays. Along with Mr Jones, I get to spend the end of the week with children from each class in Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 finding out about their achievements, talking about their week and the weekend and enjoying lively discussions ranging so far from dream holidays to super powers! The children are selected by teachers for special efforts and for successes they have had during the week.

Our approach to improving behaviour at West Jesmond is based on building up strong relationships with all of our children and knowing each child well. We then start from a positive approach where we use our West Jesmond Way to help us to identify and praise the behaviours and attitudes we want to help to develop in our children. Our reward systems help to incentivise and recognise children's efforts. Our core reward system is the Dojo scheme where children are awarded dojos that add up over time until the children gain one of our special certificates. Hot Chocolate Friday is our latest way to show our children how proud we are of all of their efforts in our school.

- Advice around sibling relationships
- Sleep routine advice
- Internet safety
- Behaviour support
- Bereavement support
- Signposting to a variety of different parenting classes such as, ESOL Maths and English courses and ESOL English as an additional language courses
