Year 4 have been busy getting ready for Spring. Volunteers from the **Friends of Jesmond Community Orchard** have been in school showing children how different species of apple tree are grafted together to produce vigorous, healthy trees. These trees will be planted in due course at various local sites and hopefully one day bear delicious fruit! Last week volunteers from the **School Allotment** helped our Year 4 children to sow vegetable and flower seeds. Over a hundred trays of compost were then returned to the allotment where they will spend the next month or two under glass as the seeds grow and are tended by KS2 children on their weekly visits. We're hoping for a bumper harvest this year, which parents will see for sale on the weekly plant stall on the KS2 yard later in the year. As a school we are so very fortunate to benefit from the many local people who devote their time and energy to share their knowledge with our children!
