Applying for a Secondary School Place for Year 7 September 2020

Please see below a message from the Local Authority Admissions Team at Newcastle Civic Centre.

"The closing date – 31 October - is quickly approaching for parents to apply for a secondary place for September 2020. As the deadline is during half term, we would appreciate your help in encouraging all parents to apply on-line NOW.

Our latest information shows that **51%** of your leaving Year 6 cohort have currently submitted an application. As you know, secondary places are extremely tight with larger cohorts of pupils and parents who don't apply on time are extremely unlikely to be offered a preferred school.

Thank you for the work that you and staff in your school do to help parents make applications, which we know can be difficult. Anything extra that you can do to help parents make applications this week is appreciated.
