English

At the start of summer term we will be undertaking a book study on Anne Fine's The Diary of a Killer Cat. This will allow us to create a character description, diary entry and letter of apology.

We will also be revisiting the genre of information texts and writing our own based on a habitat from our Amazing Animals topic. Our final pieces of work will be digitally performed on an iPad app.







At the start of the term we will be learning to tell the time, before moving on to the other measurement topics of distance, temperature, capacity and mass where we will read scales on the appropriate pieces of equipment .

Then, we will be turning our heads to learning about direction and the correct use of directional language. This knowledge will then be applied to our coding lessons.





Topic

To support our work in Science, we will be studying different habitats in our Amazing Animals topic. We will find out why certain animals and plants are suited to different habitats. We will be working with the RSPB to investigate habitats in the local environment. We'll also be meeting some animals in our classrooms.

In our Castles topic we will be studying the locations of castles in the North East. We will also look at their role, structure and importance in history and find out about the people who lived in them.
