Make Your Own Volcano

You will need:

- washing-up liquid
- baking soda

vinegar

red food colouring

• plastic cup



You could also build a paper mache volcano and put the cup inside it for extra effect!

- Fill your glass just over half way full with water. Add 3 teaspoons of baking soda and give it a good stir until most of the baking soda dissolves.
- 2 Add a good squirt of washing-up liquid into the cup and once again give it a stir.
- Make sure your volcano is in the kitchen or outside (or somewhere you don't mind making a mess).
- Quickly pour in just a quarter of a cup of vinegar and enjoy your very own volcanic eruption!

The science behind it:

You just made a chemical reaction! By mixing the acid (vinegar) and the alkali (bicarbonate of soda), bubbles of carbon dioxide (CO2) were released like in a pyroclastic flow. These move very fast and are extremely dangerous, whilst lava flows more slowly and isn't that much of a threat.
