Our Year 6 children are currently working as part of the ICCAMS Maths project which looks at addressing misconceptions within multiplication and algebra. Miss Ward has been working with a group of 20 schools including secondary and middle schools to support the learning journey of our children. On Wednesday a group of teachers, Maths specialists and Professor Hodgson from UCL attended school and observed a Maths lesson. This lesson demonstrated the high level of maths resilience our children have along with their ability to articulate their maths understanding. Both Miss Ward and Mrs Faulder were excellent in supporting the children to find additional ways to explained their understanding and justify their choices. A wonderful opportunity for best practice to be shared with a cluster of schools and our children were engaged and enthused in their learning. Well done Year 6!
