This week my daughter, Anna, and I had fun by practising some simple Spanish conversations. We have uploaded a short video so you can get some ideas for making up your own.

Perhaps you could create your own Spanish puppets for your conversation! We used simple toilet roll holders and used old wrapping paper to make brightly coloured clothes for our puppets to wear.

In your conversation, you could include:

- A greeting - you could use one of these: hola, buenos días, buenas tardes
- Asking the puppet's name: ¿Cómo te llamas?
- The puppet saying their name: Me llamo.....
- Asking how your puppet is feeling: ¿Qué tal?
- The puppet saying how they are feeling: Estoy muy bien, estoy bien, estoy mal
- Asking your puppet's age: ¿Cuántos años tienes?
- Your puppet saying their age: Tengo ocho años. I am eight years old. Your puppet could be any age you like!

If you want, you could get a grown up to film your puppet conversation and you could share it on the school Facebook or Twitter as we'd love to meet your amazing puppets.
