

English Writing


This week's writing is based on the story below, please click on the link to watch and read.

Discuss this story with your family... What do you think a memory is? Can you write a list of the things the old people said a memory is? Write a memory of something that happened to you a long time ago. Discuss how that memory made you feel.



<u>Tuesday</u>

(in school – play memory game on Eduction City – Activities – F2 – The School Bus)

Play Kim's Game - to set up = put a selection of objects on a tray (about 5 or 6), cover the objects with a cloth.

Show your child the objects, then cover them and ask if they can remember what is there.

Show your child the objects again, then remove one without your child seeing. Ask them to look at the tray and say which object is missing.

Replace that object and try again with different objects.

Look at the memories Wilfred Gordon created for Miss Nancy again.

Why are memories important?

Discuss how memories make us feel.

We can have bad memories, good memories, funny memories, sad memories.

How do you think Miss Nancy felt when Wilfred Gordon helped her remember her memories?

Task - Draw Miss Nancy's memories.

Put labels next to the memories to describe what kind of memories they are eg, happy or sad etc.


