Brexit – Settlement Status

We have received the following information from the Children's Society regarding students and families from the EU currently attending our school.

The Children's Society's: EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) support

There is support available for families from the European Union to apply for settled status in line with proposed Brexit plans. The information below provides details of drop-in and other supported sessions which are available to families:

Are you from the EU / EEA and living in the UK? Or are you a non EU/EEA family member of an EU citizen in the UK?

You need to apply for the EU settlement scheme (EUSS), to be able to continue living, working and studying in the UK after it leaves the EU (Brexit).

The Children's Society are providing support and advice for all EU / EEA nationals living in the North East, to help with completing EUSS applications.

Our service is free, and we have interpreters available if required.

· Photographic national ID (national passport / national ID card / Biometric residence card);

· Children's Birth Certificates (if relevant)

• Proof of residency in the UK (National insurance number). If you don't have one, you need letters to prove your addresses for the time you've been in the UK {this could be council tax letters / bank statements / tenancy agreements etc.);

· Proof of relationship with your dependents (eg: child birth certificate ; child benefit letter ; marriage certificate)
