Communications

Communication between home and school is always an area in which we strive to improve. The main ways we communicate with you at home about school news, clubs and events is through the Weduc App. The vast majority of our families are now using Weduc. School news and information are also shared by the **school website**, **Facebook** and **Twitter**. You can help us by making sure you check Weduc regularly and by reading these newsletters.

Birthdays Reminder

We ask that children do not bring in any food, sweets or cakes when it is their birthday. This is due to concerns about food allergies and dietary concerns and as a part of our Healthy School approach. We also hope that it eases some pressure on parents who might have felt obliged to spend money on these gifts. However, we do like to celebrate birthdays and invite children to come to school in non-uniform on the day so we can all do our best to make it feel special for them.



Music Lessons and Clubs

Many of the children in our school take up a musical instrument with tuition supplied by NEMCO (North East Music Co-operative Ltd) and external music teachers. Please speak to the school office if you would like your child to sign up for lessons. We know music tuition can be expensive and we do not want any child to miss out. If your child is, or has been, eligible for Free School Meals, we may be able to fund music tuition; please speak to us for details.

We were very proud of the number of clubs we were able provide last year and this year we hope to have even more! Please look out for information coming out to parents via Weduc. Some of our clubs will be provided by staff in school and are free for all children, we also bring in some external providers who charge a fee. If you are eligible for Free school Meals we can fund your child's place in a club, please speak with the school office for details.

Travel to School

It has been very encouraging to see how full our bike sheds and scooter racks have been this week. We still have a small number of parents driving and parking near school and once again we appeal to all of our community to make every effort to keep the streets near school as car free as possible.
