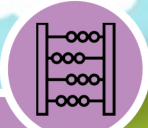


The Road To School

Speaking and Literacy

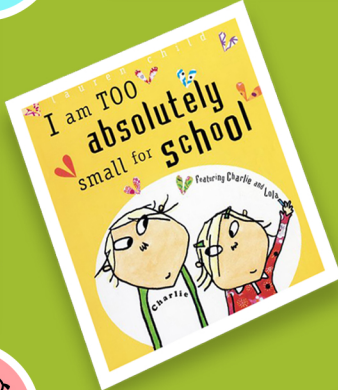
I like to share stories with a grown up and talk about the pictures

I enjoy making marks with a pen or pencil—like painting or colouring in.

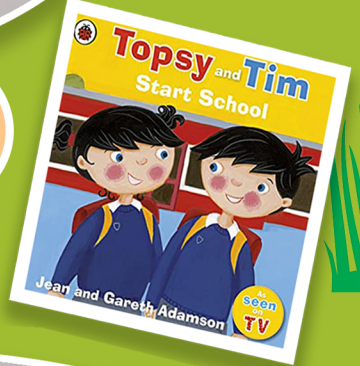


Interest in the World and New Activities

I feel happy to ask questions

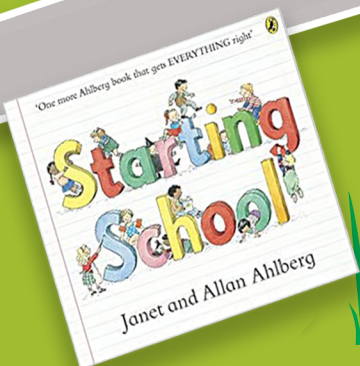


Sharing and turn taking
