Shakespeare Auditions: Over the last couple of weeks, we have really enjoyed seeing many of our Year Six children displaying a great amount of both courage and creativity as part of the audition process for this year's Shakespeare production of Romeo and Juliet as part of the Coram Shakespeare for Schools' annual festival. Last week, nearly 70 children came along to a workshop to try out a few drama



games. It was fantastic to see the children's personalities show themselves in different ways and we were so impressed with their attitudes, enthusiasm and dramatic contributions.

Then, this week, more than 40 children prepared, rehearsed and performed in the audition phase, giving us an incredibly difficult decision to make when putting the final cast together.

In fact, we have expanded the cast up to the maximum number allowed and are developing the script even further to accommodate them - the standard was that high! Many thanks go to everyone who came along and auditioned: it was great to see and we really appreciate the hard work that was put in by all participants. You should all be very proud of putting yourself forward for the play regardless of the outcome. We will keep exploring as many different opportunities as we can this year to give further opportunities to perform to those that may have missed out this time.

Congratulations to those children who are in the cast; I can't wait to get started with the rehearsals after half term! We are very excited at the prospect of the cast performing on the Northern Stage; the performance date is yet to be confirmed but is likely to be in the Spring Term. Further details will follow.
