IMPORTANT: Reminder: Ordering School Dinners from Home in 2023

When we return to school in January 2023, school will no longer be taking school meal options in school. This will be done by Parent/Carers at home using the **iPay Impact system. This includes parents who do not normally pay for meals (Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and those eligible for Free School Meals)** This will allow you to talk with your child about their choices and to have more input into what your child is eating in school. You will be able to quickly order your meals for a 3 week period in advance. You will also pay for any school meals taken using this system and not WEDUC as of January 2023.

Winter illness and Strep A Advice

Parents will be aware of widely reported cases of some childhood illnesses this year. We have been advised that increases of illnesses such as Strep A are not unusual for the time of year, but we do know that heightened awareness can raise concerns and questions about when and where to seek advice.
