HUMANITIES

This term we will be exploring the world of Ancient Greece and investigating the question, "What did the Greeks do for me?" We will complete an in-depth study of life in Ancient Greece and consider their achievements. We will also look at how the Western world has been impacted as a result.

SCIENCE

This term our focus is on Electricity. We will consider the Big Question, "Is electricity our friend?" We will be thinking about the different components that make up a simple circuit and consider which materials conduct electricity. We will also spend some time thinking about electrical safety.

MATHS

We will begin by looking at measuring perimeter and learn how to convert between different units of measure. Following this, we will use our times tables knowledge to practise using the inverse function and understanding number families. We will learn to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

ENGLISH

This term we will be focusing on Greek Myths from the 'Orchard Book of Greek Myths' by Geraldine McCaughrean. We will be using these texts to consider stories which include issues and dilemmas. We will be working on developing our descriptive writing using expanded noun phrases.
