

HUMANITIES

We are exploring the causes and impact of climate change and will be answering the big question 'What can I do?'. While analysing graphs, we will investigate the impact of greenhouse gases. The children will then create their own persuasive adverts to demonstrate what they can do to help.

SCIENCE

We are focusing on planning different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions. We will use the results to make further predictions and to set up more tests. We will report and present findings from our tests using speaking and written results. Our topic will be light.

MATHS

Maths this term we continue to build on fluency, reasoning and problem-solving. We will be recapping the four operations. When secure with this, the children will move on to explore fractions, decimals and percentages. During lessons, we will also continue to practise a range of arithmetic skills.

ENGLISH

Our text for this half term is Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick. We will build up to write a persuasive speech in the character of 'Zoe' and during lessons will study sentence level skills that will help with this. The children will also continue to learn new grammar and spelling rules.
